The Open Door Traveller Scheme is a free printable you can put up in your motorhome any time you are open to conversation. It's meant as a friendly beacon to encourage mini connections while travelling. Remember smiles are contagious

A few guidelines for a smooth welcome:

- Green side = knock, say hi, let's chat
- Red side = usually I'd love to chat but I'm a bit busy at the moment, try again when I'm green
- Put the sign in an easily visible place - passenger side windscreen is a good option
- Biscuits and cake are not guaranteed
- Please respect each other
- Don't be predatory
- Don't be offended if not invited in - different people have different personal space. A hello outside can be just as nice
- Some hellos are quick, others a bit longer - take care not to overstay your welcome
- Only knock if the green sign is visible at time of knocking (they may have taken it down to focus on dinner or fold socks)

While 99.9 % of people are lovely, we have some safety tips to consider:

- Trust your instincts
- Be especially careful if on your own
- Don't invite in if don't feel comfortable
- You are not obliged to do anything
